

Secura No. 15 Stripper: Best in class equipped with four blades

JOKARI has re-developed its approved Secura No. 15 Stripper. The new equipment with four blades leads to significant advantages for users.

Secura No. 15 Stripper is one of the most famous wire strippers in JOKARI's broad range. For a simple reason: Professionals in electronics and other areas regularly use the tool for stripping all common round cables with diameters from 8 to 13 mm. But JOKARI is recognized for developing even approves products, and such the wire stripper specialists has equipped the Secura No. 15 Stripper with four instead of two blades in the latest edition. "Our users breathed the wish to extend the number of blades from two to four to make our stripper even better. Accordingly, we have introduced the tool with a quadruple array of blades", JOKARI managing director Carsten Bünnigmann states.

The new equipment with four blades leads, among other specifications, to a better grip, especially in lower diameter levels, for example with type NYM wires (3x1,5mm²). Additionally, work is simplified through a reduced rotation in cavity wall sockets and a clean course of the cut. That comes from the almost round array of the blades, as Carsten Bünnigmann points out. An additional advantage: The two-blade technology is applied at two points of the wire. With the four blade version users have four application points and thus a longer edge and a higher cutting performance. The four-blade version offers a higher stability than the two-blade technology.

According to Carsten Bünnigmann, the development of the Secura No. 15 Stripper as a four-blade tool has led to a re-design of the tip of the tool, too. "We have development a special construction to close the cavity behind the blades even in the version with four blades. Without doing so users would have to remove wire leftovers collected in the cavity. We worked hard to avoid that." This follow the general JOKARI concept to simplify the work for professionals as good as possible.

The new Secura No. 15 Stripper has been successfully introduced as proven by international trade fair presentations and readers' surveys in different special interest magazines. "The classical version with two blades was best in class constantly. Now we have succeeded in optimizing the tool to generate added value", the JOKARI managing partner says.
