

New equipment for Jokari wire strippers

Wire stripper specialist Jokari's new Locator-system is a power and level limiter for the tools Allrounder and Uni-Plus. The product makes the work safer and more precise and prevents the blade from damaging the inner conductors.

In spring 2014 family-run Jokari from Ascheberg, Westphalia, which ranks among the global top high-quality wire stripper producers, presented a real innovation: the wire stripper Allrounder. The tool can be used with round and flat cables in many working fields.

That wire stripper and long-selling, functional Uni-Plus can now be equipped with process-reliable accessory. "With our new Locator-system users can add to the Allrounder a power and level limiter, the so-called Locator", Carsten Bünnigmann explains. Stripping wires with a varied thickness of the outer coating hardens the task not to damage the inner conductors for hand pressure and cutting depth of the blades cannot be controlled properly. According to Carsten Bünnigmann, that complicates precise stripping, because the blades penetrate the coating too deep. The Locator-system guarantees the intactness of the inner conductors.

Wire stripping lacked a tool such as Locator-system to make the work safer and quicker as well as more safety, Bünnigmann says. "During the first field trials our tester realized the value of the Locator-system in the daily routine."

But how does the new system work? The longitudinal stop of the Allrounder is switched with the Locator, the height of the setscrew is adjusted to the thickness of the conductor with the hex key. The distance of the blades can be precisely defined in a diameter range of 4 to 11,9 mm, and thus the penetration of the blades can be limited precisely to the necessary depth.

There is no change in using the tools. The Locator does not stop or change the stripping process, the power and level limiter is not noticeable. In the end the user will achieve a more precise stripping result that will simplify stripping different wires considerably. The Locator-system avoids cutting wounds and achieves a mandatory level of process safety in wire stripping.

Jokari has equipped the Locator-box widely. It contains four Locators in different colors, a hex key for size adjustment and is stored in the grip of Allrounder or Uni-Plus. The multi-colored Locators make it easy to reserve uniquely adjusted Locators for returning wires.

Jokari-Krampe LLC from Ascheberg, Westphalia, is a global market leader for the production and distribution of high-quality precision wire strippers. Since its foundation more than 45 years ago, the company has been focusing on quality made in Germany and manufactures all wire strippers in its own factory with an attached plastics injection molding at the Ascheberg headquarter.
